Annex A: Melling Legal general terms and conditions

- 1. Melling Legal is the trade name of Melling B.V., registered in the Trade Register under number 83233253 (**Melling Legal**)
- 2. These general terms and conditions apply to all instructions for services (*opdrachten*) by the client (**Client**) to as well as all other services provided by Melling Legal.
